

June 22, 2010 - Polling Place Locations

Your voted ballot must be received by the elections official by 8 p.m., Tuesday, June 22, 2010.

If you are registered to vote in Santa Cruz County, you may return your ballot by:

- Mailing it in the return envelope provided. Allow sufficient time for the ballot to be received by 8 p.m., Tuesday, June 22.
- Hand delivering it to any polling place in this county on Election Day between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. Below is a list of the polling places for the June 22, 2010 Election.
- Hand delivering it to the County Clerk/Elections Department at 701 Ocean Street, Room 210, Santa Cruz, Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Hand delivering it to the City Clerks' offices in Santa Cruz, Scotts Valley, or Watsonville during regular business hours.
- 24-hour return is available by dropping it in the white receptacle in front of the county building or the green box at 215 Union St. behind Watsonville City Hall beginning June 1, 2010 – no postage required.
- Extended office hours are available at the County Clerk/Elections Department and Watsonville Civic Center located at 275 Main St., 4th Floor, on Saturday, June 19, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
